

This is a drawing of the top of the artist's desk with the desk lamp on. The lamp is shining on an open book. There are 3 stacked books to the right of the desk. Behind the desk is the window at night. The sky is dark purple with blue clouds. We can see the black shape of a builder's crane against the sky and we can see the pink roof of a building

e. Write x 4 lines saying what you think is good about this artwork:

What I think is good about this drawing is the way the light from the lamp is drawn, The artist uses loads of thin lines in yellow to show the light shining on the open book. I love the colours used in this. Even though it's a nighttime scene, the colours are really bright - yellow, white, pink, blue and purple are the main colours.
