

## **Student Supports**

Each Year Group has a designated *Year Head*, who is a member of the school's senior management team. The Year Head is an important figure in the school's academic, discipline and pastoral care system. The Year Head's main role is to support the work of the individual teachers and to organise the year group in the most effective and responsive manner. The Year Head will normally be involved in working with class teachers to ensure that students are happy, safe and challenged in school, that their attendance and punctuality is as high as possible, that students are responding appropriately to the academic demands of school, that students are involved in the co-curricular elements of Curragh Post School and, ultimately, that students are developing a level of maturity and inner confidence that will enable them to leave Curragh Post School with a sense of pride in their community, local and national, and with a deep sense that they can make a real and valuable contribution to society as adults.

To further assist students' in their learning, development and education, Curragh Post Primary School provides the following additional support services:

Guidance Counsellor (Ms. A. Cleary);

School Completion Programme (Coordinator, Ms. J. Yorke) and

Home School Liaison Officer (Mr. K. O'Toole).

There is, also, a special government funded Breakfast Club for students each morning.
